1. Package contents

The **clearaudio** *Statement TT 1 Tangential* tonearm is delivered in specially designed packaging to ensure its safe transport. Please check the contents as shown in picture below and in the list at the bottom of this page:

2. Package view

The Statement TT 1 is packed in a special foam packing and comes almost completely assembled.

Tonearm chassis, not including the armwand.

The armwand and the glastube are packed separately and need to be installed.

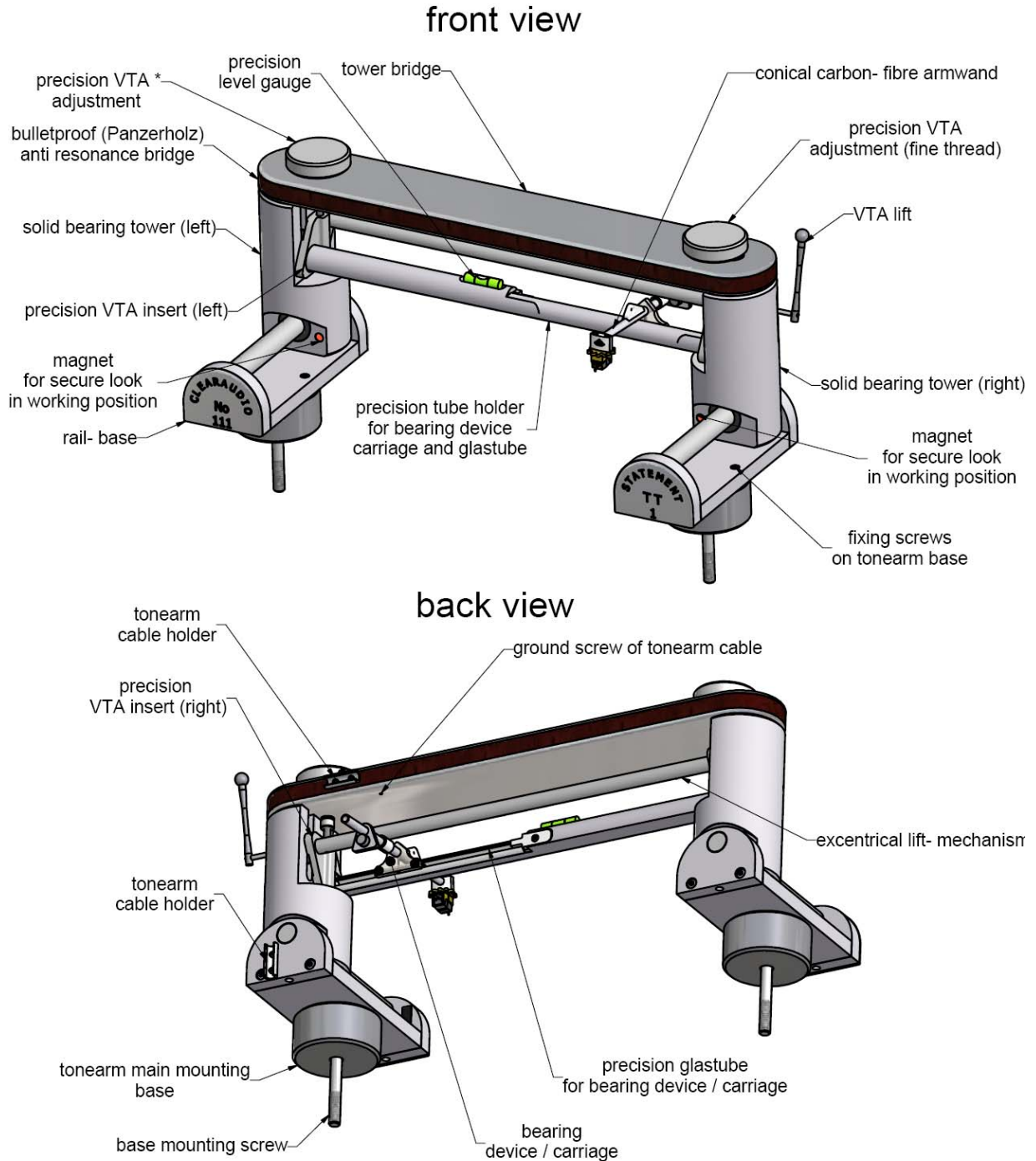


Picture 2: Armwand and glastube

The accessories, tools etc. are packed as well separately.

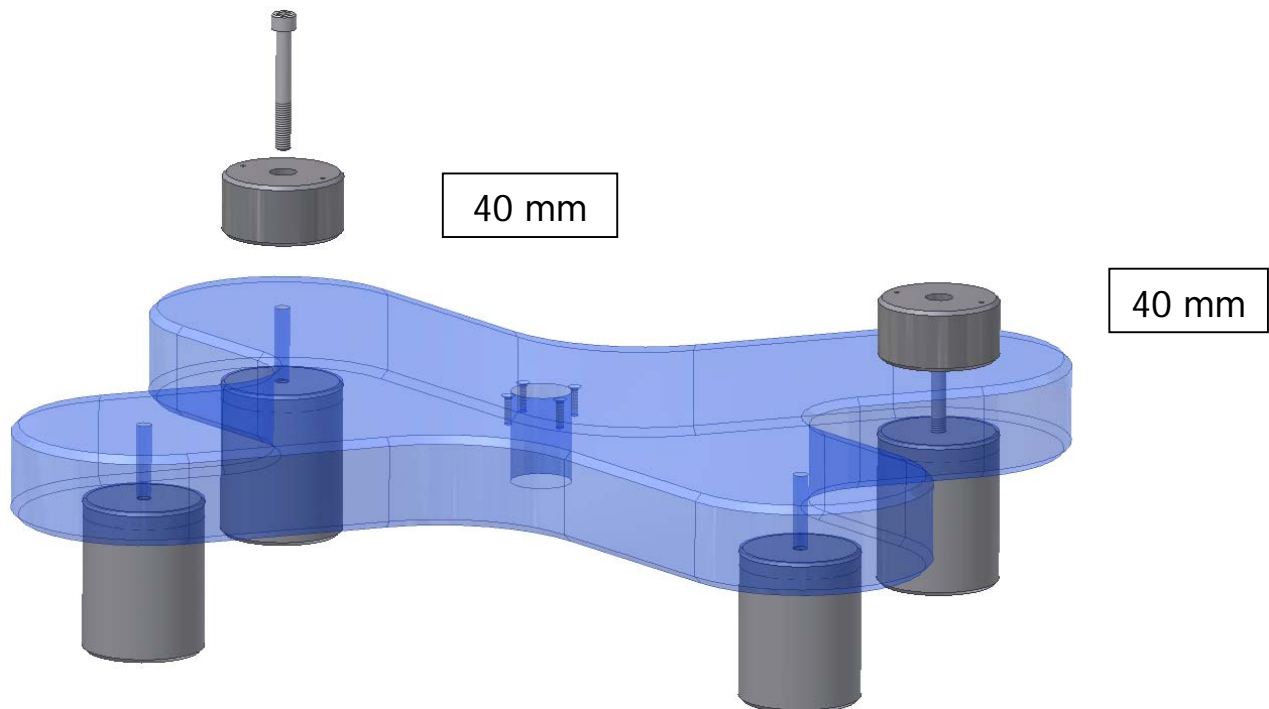

4. Preassembly and operation

After checking the package contents as described, place the parts on a clean, safe and flat surface to get ready for the setup. The assembly and setup is fairly simple and straight forward as many parts have been already preassembled at the factory. Please use the white gloves provided, to prevent scratches and/or fingerprints during assembly.

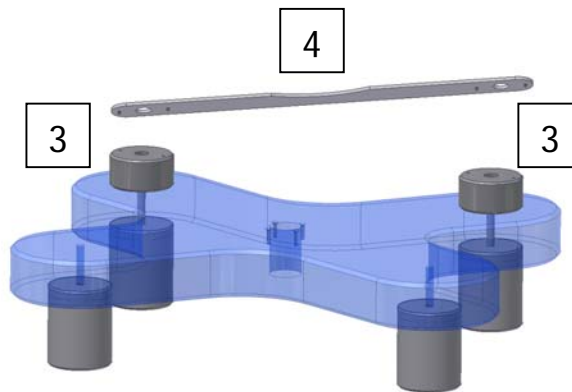
First you start to assembly the 2 main tonearm stainless steel round base (stainless steel cylinders) on to the Statement turntable. Please note, you might have to take off the previous cylinders, please use only the provided one's, as they are matched in height for the TT1 tonearm.



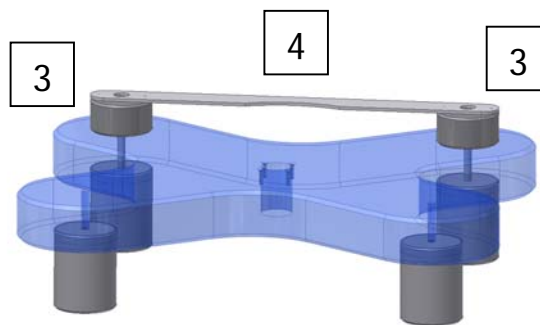
Picture 4: Putting the stainless steel round base onto the Statement turntable

Do not tighten the cylinders completely, you should be still able to turn them.

Now place the installation gauge (4) for the tonearm base on top of the two cylinders (3) while all four pins on the bottom of the installation gauge, must fit into the threats machined into the cylinders. You might have to turn the cylinders for correnty aligning.

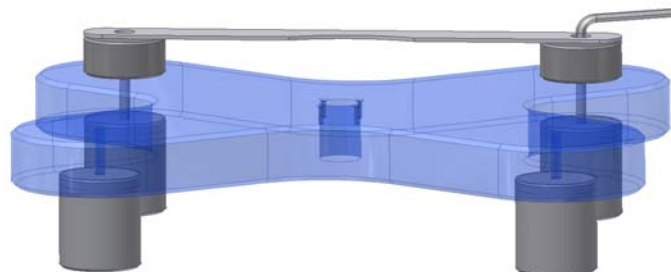


Picture 5: Placing the installation gauge

Tighten the 2 bolts, with the provided hex key, while holding (pressing) the gauge down.
Attention: any misalignment will lead to a problem to place the TT1 tonearm later !

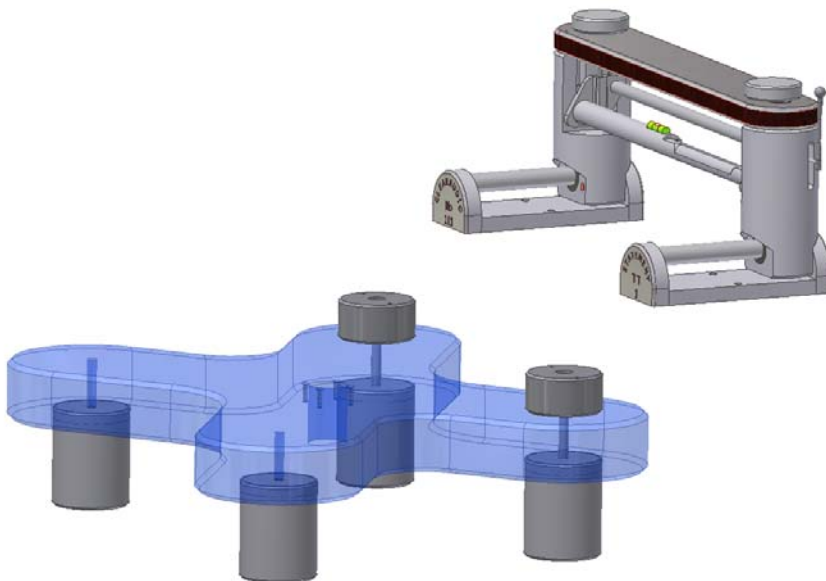


Picture 7: Tighten the gauge

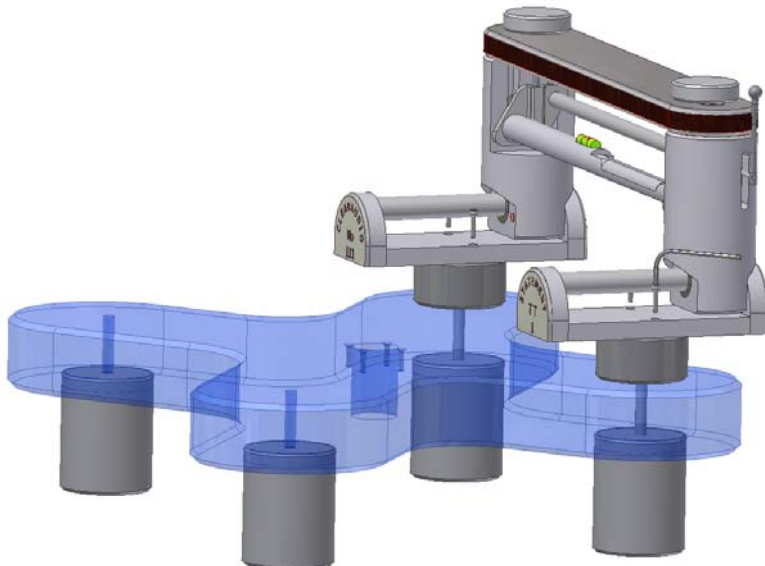
5. Statement TT1 tonearm mounting on Statement

Now you can place the tonearm chassis on top of the 2 cylinders. Take it carefully with one hand at the top cover (tower bridge), so that the sliding bars are not moving. While holding it in place, over the 4 machined threads, start inserting the provided (4) hex key screws and tighten them.

Please note: Always hold the tonearm in place while fixing the 4 screws!

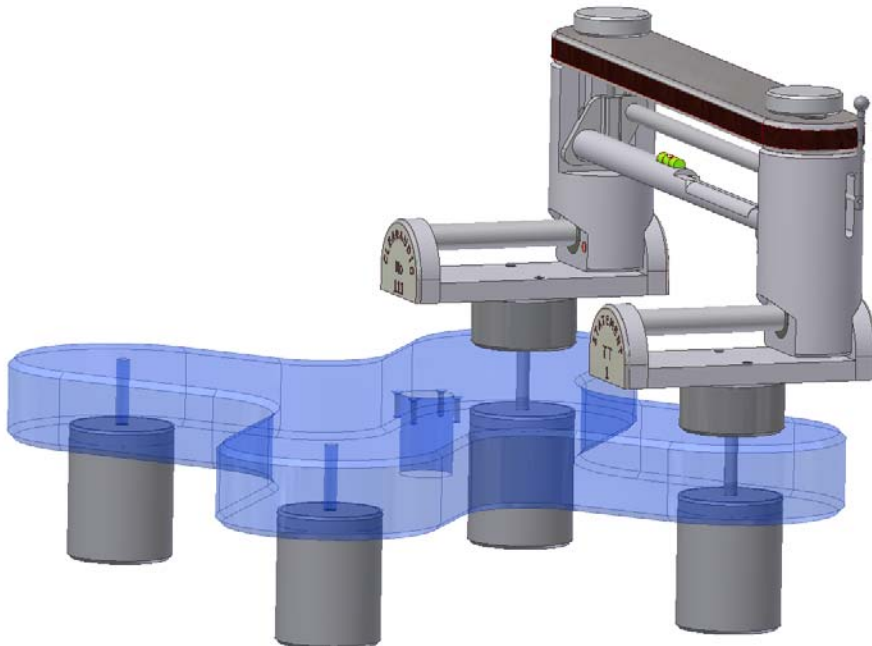


Picture 8: Placing the tonearm chassis on the top

Tighten the screws, one by one, gently but firm.

Please note:

You might have to readjust the leveling of the Statement turntable, when finished with the complete setup.

The following steps must be done with a lot of caution !

Take the precision glastube and the armwand / carriage assembly and slide it into the glastube. The headshell mounting area is facing into the direction that the cut out gap of the tube in the back.

Please note: There is no tension force allowed to the very fine/ thin tonearm cable. Damage can occur !

Place the glastube assembly kit as described:

first the piece with the round rubber at the right end of the glastube in position (inserting), then the round stopper into the left side of the glastube.

Now slide the glastube into the machined precision tube holder (at the back of the TT1 tonearm) and place it into the buffer by pushing it into the left rubber ring

Attention: Put the glastube flat into the cut out, then push it leftwards! Damage can occur !

Now you just have to place the tonearm cable into the assembled tonearm cable holder at the back of the tonearm. Please make sure that the tonearm cable makes a loop, so that there is enough freedom for the cable, while sliding the tonearm back and forward.

Please note: You might want to fix the tonearm cable with a tape to the tower bridge.

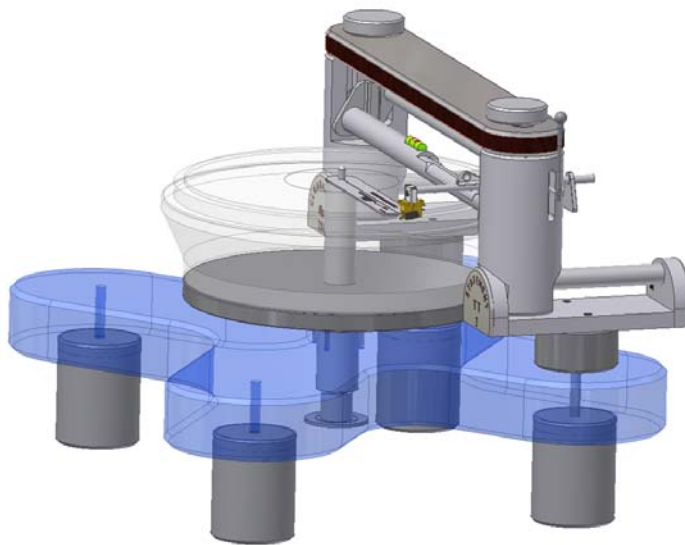
The tonearm cable is equipped with a ground washer. Take the attached ground screw, below the tower bridge and attached the ground washer, while screwing it in the associated thread.

6. Cartridge pre-adjustments

First mount the cartridge into the headshell, with the provided two headshell screws.

Place a record on the platter in order to install the height and VTA.

Turn the two knobs of precision VTA adjustment (wheels) on top of the tonearm till the armwandaxis is parallel to the Record surface.

Cartridge adjustment

The correct tangential adjustment is mandatory.

For the correct adjustment use the cartridge alignment gauge, which needs to be placed on the spindle first.

The diamond tip of the cartridge must be always aligned in the blackline (groove) of the gauge.

This fine adjustment can be realised by moving the armwand back or forward.

Simply lock or unlock the screw on the bottom of the carriage.

Weight adjustment :

Slide the appropriate exchangeable counter weight over the back of the armwand tube and adjust the correct tracking force.

Please hold the armwand carefully in order not to put too much force to the bearings.

For the best results we recommend the use of the clearaudio weight watcher stylus force gauge.

- (e.g. 10 g for Goldfinger or 5 g for Titanium)

7. Transportation advice

If any transportation of the *Statement TT1* tonearm should be necessary, please always use original packing material. Otherwise serious damage could occur!

The armwand needs to be built out, to avoid any possible damage as well

If the Statement TT1 tonearm is not in use for a longer period, please cover the tonearm in order to prevent it from dust.

You can clean the glastube with pure alcohol.

Please make sure that the precision dry ball bearings should not be touched, cleaned or lubricated in any aspect. Please clean only the glastube !

WARNING:

Never insert the oil into the precision bearing! This will result in damage of bearing!
